

Much More

Romans 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

Romans 5:10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, **much more**, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Romans 5:15 But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, **much more** did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.

Romans 5:17 For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, **much more** those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Matthew 6:26 Look at the birds of the air, that they do not sow, nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not worth **much more** than they?

Matthew 6:30 But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, will He not **much more** clothe you? You of little faith!

Matthew 7:11 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how **much more** will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him!

Matthew 10:25 It is enough for the disciple that he become like his teacher, and the slave like his master. If they have called the head of the house Beelzebul, how **much more** will they malign the members of his household!

Matthew 12:12 How **much more** valuable then is a man than a sheep! So then, it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath.”

Mark 12:33 and to love Him with all the heart and with all the understanding and with all the strength, and to love one’s neighbor as himself, is **much more** than all burnt offerings and sacrifices.”

Romans 11:12 Now if their transgression is riches for the world and their failure is riches for the Gentiles, how **much more** will their fulfillment be!

II Corinthians 3:9 For if the ministry of condemnation has glory, **much more** does the ministry of righteousness abound in glory.

II Corinthians 3:11 For if that which fades away was with glory, **much more** that which remains is in glory.

Hebrews 1:4 having become as **much better** than the angels, as He has inherited a **more excellent** name than they.

Romans 8:3 For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God did: sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and as an offering for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh,

John 3:17 For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

Philippians 2:6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,

II Peter 2:4 For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment;

II Timothy 1:6 For this reason I **remind** you to kindle afresh the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

II Timothy 2:14 **Remind** them of these things, and solemnly exhort them in the presence of God not to dispute about words, which is useless and leads to the ruin of the listeners.

Titus 3:1 **Remind** them to be subject to rulers, to authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good deed,

II Peter 1:12 Therefore, I will always be ready to **remind** you of these things, even though you already know them and have been established in the truth which is present with you.

II Peter 1:13 I consider it right, as long as I am in this earthly dwelling, to stir you up by way of **reminder**,

II Peter 3:1 Beloved, this is now the second letter I am writing to you in which I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of a **reminder**,

Jude 1:5 Now I want to **remind** you, though you know everything once and for all, that the Lord, after saving a people out of the land of Egypt, subsequently destroyed those who did not believe.

Forgot // Forgotten... (the opposite of remember – what is the result of forgetting?)

Peter 1:9 For the one who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having **forgotten** his purification from his former sins.

Judges 3:7 So the sons of Israel did what was evil in the sight of the Lord, and they **forgot** the Lord their God and served the Baals and the Asheroth.

Psalms 78:11 They **forgot** His deeds And His miracles that He had shown them.

Psalms 106:13 They quickly **forgot** His works; They did not wait for His plan,

Psalms 106:21 They **forgot** God their Savior, Who had done great things in Egypt,

Isaiah 17:10 For you have **forgotten** the God of your salvation And have not remembered the rock of your refuge. Therefore you plant delightful plants And set them with vine shoots of a strange god.

Jeremiah 3:21 A voice is heard on the bare heights, The weeping, the pleading of the sons of Israel. Because they have perverted their way, They have **forgotten** the Lord their God.

Jeremiah 13:25 This is your lot, the portion measured to you From Me," declares the Lord, "Because you have **forgotten** Me And trusted in falsehood.

Ezekiel 23:35 Therefore, this is what the Lord God says: 'Because you have **forgotten** Me and discarded Me behind your back, suffer on your own part the punishment for your outrageous sin and your obscene practices.'

There are some things we are to forget –

Philippians 3:13, 14 Brothers and sisters, I do not regard myself as having taken hold of it yet; but one thing I do: **forgetting** what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

Psalms 119:49 **Remember** the word to Your servant, In which You have made me hope.

I Cor. 11:23-26 **23** For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in **remembrance** of Me." 25 In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in **remembrance** of Me." 26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

II Pet. 3:1,2 Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both of which I stir up your pure minds by way of **reminder**), 2 that you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us, the apostles of the Lord and Savior,

Heb. 13:7 **Remember** those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct.

Phil. 1:3 I thank my God upon every **remembrance** of you,

Luke 24:6-9 He is not here, but is risen! **remember** how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, 7 saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.' 8 And they **remembered** His words. 9 Then they returned from the tomb and told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest.

Psalm 119:52 I **remember** your laws from long ago, and they comfort me, Lord.

v.55 I **remember** Your name in the night, O Lord, And I keep Your law.

Psalm 143:5 I **remember** the days of old; I meditate on all Your works, I muse on the work of Your hands.

Psalm 63:6-8 When I **remember** You on my bed, I meditate on You in the night watches. 7 Because You have been my help, Therefore in the shadow of Your wings I will rejoice. 8 My soul follows close behind You; Your right hand upholds me.

Psalm 25:7 **Do not remember** the sins of my youth or my wrongdoings; **Remember** me according to Your faithfulness, For Your goodness' sake, Lord.

Psalm 77:11-13 I shall **remember** the deeds of the Lord; I will certainly **remember** Your wonders of old. 12 I will meditate on all Your work, And on Your deeds with thanksgiving. 13 Your way, God, is holy; What god is great like our God?

Psalm 78:40-42 How often they rebelled against Him in the wilderness And grieved Him in the desert! 41 Again and again they tempted God, And pained the Holy One of Israel. 42 **They did not remember** His power, The day when He redeemed them from the enemy,

Psalm 106:7 Our fathers in Egypt did not understand Your wonders; They **did not remember** Your abundant kindnesses, But rebelled by the sea, at the Red Sea.

Judges 8:34 So the sons of Israel **did not remember** the Lord their God, who had saved them from the hands of all their enemies on every side;

Psalm 103:17,18 But the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting for those who fear Him, And His justice to the children's children, 18 To those who keep His covenant And **remember** His precepts, so as to do them.

Ecclesiastes 12:1 **Remember** also your Creator in the days of your youth, before the evil days come and the years approach when you will say, "I have no pleasure in them";

Ecclesiastes 12:6 **Remember** your Creator before the silver cord is broken and the golden bowl is crushed, the pitcher by the spring is shattered and the wheel at the

cistern is crushed;

Isaiah 26:8 Indeed, while following the way of Your judgments, Lord, We have waited for You eagerly; Your name, and **remembering** You, is the desire of our souls.

Isaiah 43:25 "I alone, am the one who wipes out your wrongdoings for My own sake, And **I will not remember** your sins.

Isaiah 46:9,10 **Remember** the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, 10 Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, 'My plan will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure';

Jonah 2:7 While I was fainting away, I **remembered** the Lord, And my prayer came to You, Into Your holy temple.

Exodus 13:3 And Moses said to the people, "**Remember** this day in which you departed from Egypt, from the house of slavery; for by a powerful hand the Lord brought you out from this place. And nothing with yeast shall be eaten.

Deuteronomy 15:15 And you are to **remember** that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God redeemed you; therefore I am commanding this of you today.

Deuteronomy 7:18 you are not to be afraid of them; you shall **remember** well what the Lord your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt:

Nehemiah 4:14 When I saw their fear, I stood and said to the nobles, the officials, and the rest of the people: "Do not be afraid of them; **remember** the Lord who is great and awesome, and fight for your brothers, your sons, your daughters, your wives, and your houses."

1 Peter 1:7 “so that the **proof of your faith**, being more precious than gold which perishes though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ;”

1 Peter 1:9 “**obtaining as the outcome of your faith**, the salvation of your souls.”

1 Peter 1:21 “who through Him are believers in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that **your faith and hope are in God.**”

Genesis 6:9 Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his time; Noah **walked with God**.

Deuteronomy 5:33 You shall walk in all the way which the LORD your God has commanded you, that you may live and that it may be well with you, and that you may prolong your days in the land which you will possess.

Deuteronomy 6:7 You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and **when you walk by the way** and when you lie down and when you rise up.

Deuteronomy 8:6 Therefore, you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God, to **walk in His ways** and to fear Him.

Deuteronomy 11:22 For if you are careful to keep all this commandment which I am commanding you to do, to love the LORD your God, to **walk in all His ways** and hold fast to Him,

Psalm 89:15 How blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! O LORD, they **walk in the light** of Your countenance.

II Corinthians 5:7 for we **walk** by faith, not by sight—

Colossians 2:6 Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so **walk** in Him,

1 John 1:6,7 If we say that we have fellowship with Him and *yet* **walk** in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth; 7 but if we **walk** in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Galatians 5:16 But I say, **walk** by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would **walk** in them.

Ephesians 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to **walk** in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

Ephesians 5:2 and **walk** in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

Ephesians 5:15 Therefore be careful how you **walk**, not as unwise men but as wise,

Romans 6:4 Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might **walk** in newness of life.

John 8:12 Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not **walk** in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."

Psalm 1:1 How blessed is the man **who does not walk** in the counsel of the wicked, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers

Psalm 23:4 **Even though I walk through** the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for **You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.**

III John 1:4 I have no greater joy than this, to hear of my children **walking** in the truth.

Colossians 1:10 so that you will **walk** in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

1 Thessalonians 2:12 so that you would **walk** in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

1 John 2:6 the one who says he abides in Him ought himself to **walk** in the same manner as He **walked**.

Psalm 84:11 For the LORD God is a sun and shield; The LORD gives grace and glory; No good thing does He withhold from those **who walk uprightly**

Proverbs 13:20 **He who walks** with wise men will be wise, But the companion of fools will suffer harm.

Proverbs 14:2 **He who walks** in his uprightness fears the LORD, But he who is devious in his ways despises Him.

Proverbs 15:21 Folly is joy to him who lacks sense, But a man of understanding **walks straight**.

Deuteronomy 10:12 "Now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require from you, but to fear the LORD your God, to **walk in all His ways** and love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all

your heart and with all your soul,

Ephesians 4:17 So this I say, and affirm together with the Lord, that you **walk** no longer just as the Gentiles also **walk**, in the futility of their mind,

Ephesians 5:8 for you were formerly darkness, but now you are Light in the Lord; **walk as children of Light**

Ephesians 2:2 in which you **formerly walked** according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience.

Romans 8:4 so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us, **who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit**.

Romans 14:15 For if because of food your brother is hurt, you are no longer **walking according to love**. Do not destroy with your food him for whom Christ died.

II Corinthians 4:2 but we have renounced the things hidden because of shame, **not walking in craftiness** or adulterating the word of God, but by the manifestation of truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

II Corinthians 6:16 Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND **WALK AMONG THEM**; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE.

II Corinthians 10:2,3 I ask that when I am present I need not be bold with the confidence with which I propose to be courageous against some, who regard us

as if we walked according to the flesh.

3 For though we **walk** in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh,

Galatians 5:25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also **walk by the Spirit**.

Philippians 3:17 Brethren, join in following my example, and observe those **who walk according** to the pattern you have in us.

Philippians 3:18 For **many walk**, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even weeping, that they are enemies of the cross of Christ,

1 Thessalonians 4:1 Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us instruction as to how you ought to **walk and please God** (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more.

1 John 2:11 But the one who hates his brother is in the darkness and **walks in the darkness**, and does not know where he is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

II John 1:4 I was very glad to find some of your children **walking in truth**, just as we have received commandment to do from the Father.

II John 1:6 And this is love, that **we walk according to His commandments**. This is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, that **you should walk in it**.
